Saltram Class




S is our star learner this week for his super star start at Beechwood. He has settled in brilliantly and is following all of our golden rules. Well done S, keep up the good work!

Dockyard Class




Our star learner this week is L for a super positive attitude and excellent listening skills in cricket coaching and martial arts training. Well done L!
