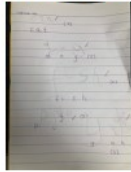

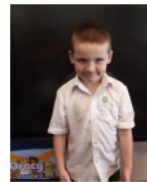
L is our star learner this week because he has been trying really hard to hold a pencil correctly and form some of the letters in his name. Well done L!

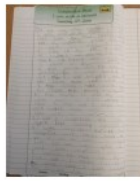
