

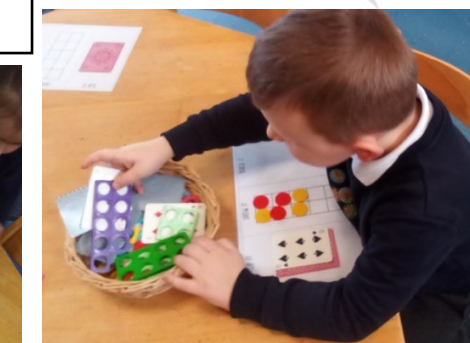
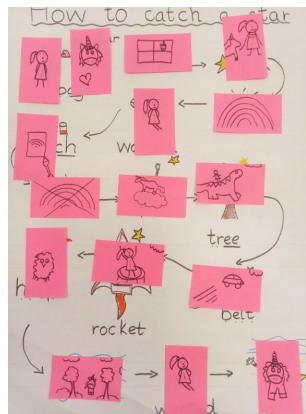

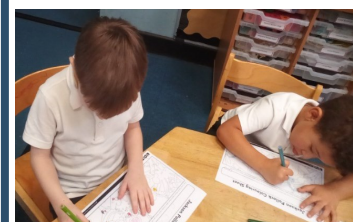
Reception 'To Infinity and Beyond'

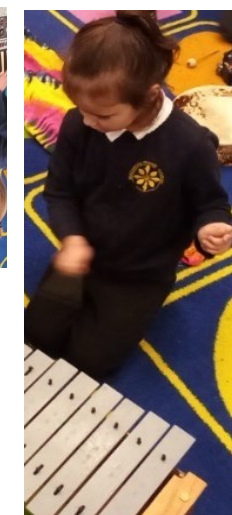
This term the children have enjoyed learning about space. We have read many fiction and non fiction books and listened to lots of space songs. The children have use blocks to create their own structures and space rockets.
