

# Weston Mill Community Primary Academy Autumn Term Learning Year 4 ~ 2024-2025



### Autumn Term

On the reverse, please find an outline of your child's learning for Autumn Term I and 2.

We will be focusing on settling back into school after a great summer break. We are so pleased to see the children getting on well in their new classes and the progress they have been making so far.

# How you can help:

Reading, times tables and spellings are the main areas you can make a huge difference with at home, and these are what we expect the children to complete as homework each week.

Reading books are changed when the children have completed their REN (Renaissance Reading Program) reading quiz. Children should try to read with an adult every day; a good guide about 15 minutes per day. It is even more helpful if you can ask them questions about what they have been reading, or to predict what they think will happen next.

Each week, your child will be given a list of spellings for their age group. The spelling sheet contains the spellings and also some quick activities linking to the spellings such as how many syllables the words have or a sentence with a blank space for the spelling. Children are tested once a week, on a Friday. You can really support your child by helping them to learn their spellings at home. A few minutes each evening or as you are walking to or from school will make all the difference.

Children in Y4 will be expected to learn all the times tables up to 12x12 by the end of the year. Each week, the children will have a short times tables test and when they have completed three of these with only a few errors, they will move onto their next times table. When they have learnt up to the 12x table, they will have a grid format which helps them remember all their tables. Children have access to a website called Times Tables Rockstars which they will have their password for, and it helps them to practice their tables in an engaging way. You can also help by listening to the children recite their tables or asking questions for the children to answer.

### <u> PE</u>

The children will continue to participate in PE sessions each week. Our topic this term follows the 'Cambridge PE' curriculum, focusing on core skills. On our PE day, Year 4, children will be required to come into school in their PE kit. The children will be going inside and outside and will need suitable outside kit including trainers or plimsolls. School PE kit is a white t-shirt, black shorts/jogging bottoms, their school jumper or cardigan, socks and trainers or plimsolls. Our usual PE days will be Tuesday and Thursday.

MATHS: This term the children will focus on place value, then addition and subtraction. We will continue to have weekly times tables practice and tests.

COMPUTING: In computing this term, we will research topics and also complete National Online Safety (self-image and identity).



DISCOVERY

PSHE: We will be learning about how to manage our feelings, health and wellbeing.

PE: Games-ball handling **Gymnastics**  FRENCH: We will be continuing to learn French this term.

ENGLISH: Year 4 will begin by writing their own narratives based using inspiration from the book The Whale. Following this, children will use the same text to support them to write a newspaper report.

HISTORY: We will be studying the early civilisation - Shang Dynasty. This include locating China, creating timelines and research the contribution of this ancient culture to modern civilisations. We will investigate their amazing inventions.



TERM I: Shang Dynasty

BIG OUESTION: What caused the fall of the Shang Dynasty?

DESTINATION: To create a quiz based on the Shang Dynasty.

DT: We will be researching Shang Dynasty transportation, then making and evaluating our own chariots.

RE: We will be looking at the religion Christianity. We will find out what is the 'Trinity' and why is it important for Christians?

MATHS: During Term 2, pupils will learn about calculating area. Following this the topic will be multiplication and division. Again, children will continue to have weekly times tables practice and tests.

ENGLISH: Year 4 will begin by writing their own narratives based using inspiration from the book Leaf. Following this, children will use the same text to support them to write an information report.

GEOGRAPHY: Year 4 will research human and physical features of North America incusing countries, mountain ranges, and rivers. These will be used to compare to the geography of the United Kingdom.

COMPUTING: For our National Online Safety unit, we will look at online relationships and online reputation.

RE: What do Hindus believe God is like?

SCIENCE: We will be learning about the states of matter - liquid, solid and gas, through comparing materials. We will also learn about how states of matter can change and the water cycle.

TERM 2: Journey through North America

BIG OUESTION: How does water travel through North America?

DESTINATION: To explain and present the process of the Water Cycle.

ART: Children will look at the artist Monet. We will use his landscapes to inspire our own designs, drawn using

pastels.

MUSIC: We will learn to play notes on the recorder and play song.
