Each month has a different theme. Complete the special challenges (or borrow 4 more books) to receive a trading card.

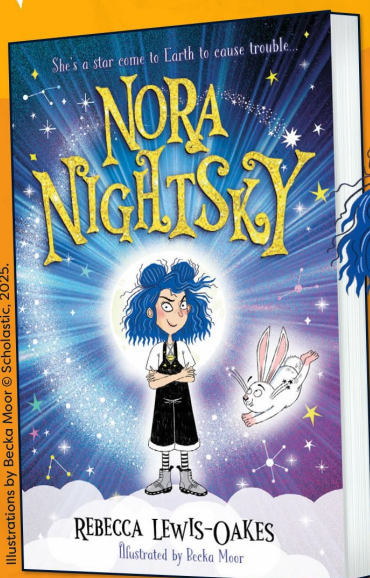
