YEAR 1 ART


Year 1 are really enjoying their art lessons this term, focusing on the work of artist Frida Kahlo.

We have explored some of her amazing paintings and can't wait to paint some of our own portraits of famous women in history.

These will be shared with Year 1 parents at our gallery which will be on Thursday 23rd May (a separate letter has been sent home about this event).









This week in art we have discovered what the primary colours are. These are red, blue and yellow. We used paint to explore these colours before moving on to mixing them to create secondary colours. If you mix red and blue you create purple. Mixing yellow and blue makes green. Mixing red and yellow makes orange. It was great fun using paint to explore colours and we are looking forward to sharing our final portraits with you in a few weeks.

Do you sometimes struggle to provide food for your family?

Please do not struggle in silence. Devon and Cornwall Food Action Trust are a local based charity based (Widewell) and are able to provide food boxes at a cost of £25.00 (£60.00 worth of food). Donations are required as they are not a registered food bank, but a support charity. You do not need to be in receipt of any benefits to use this service. Each and every donation enables them to reinvest into their charity and continue supporting and feeding the local communities. It goes towards electricity, storage, refrigeration, warehouse costs, vehicle upkeep and fuel.

Not only are they repurposing otherwise lost-to-landfill food and other donated goods but they are feeding individuals and families at the same time. They are a full circle charity for those facing a period of food poverty or food crisis but don't necessarily require the service of a food bank.

The food boxes are known to be bursting at the seams with a wide variety of goods including fresh, frozen, tinned and ambient products. Where they can, they also try to include additional items such as household goods or toiletries. There may also be seasonal goods due to a change of packaging.

Not only is this at a fraction of the cost of goods in-store; it also saves food waste and in turn, keeps the lights on at DCFA so they can keep doing what they do best; feed the community and eradicate food waste.


