Mobile phones

Just to let you know that the children have been spoken to about bringing mobile phones to school. Below is what was discussed with all pupils in Keystage2. We will be following these processes and procedures from today.

- 1. All pupil mobile phones to be handed into the class teacher each morning on entry to school.
- 2. If children go to Breakfast Club they need to hand their phone to a member of staff as they enter the building.
- 3. Phones will be locked away during the day.
- 4. Mobile phones are handed out to pupils as they leave the building through the pod door and not before.
- 5. CLUBS If children are going to a club, phones need to be left in the office until the club is finished, at which point the adult in charge will collect the phone for them.
- 6. If a child refuses to hand over a mobile phone, a member of staff will contact the parents.
- 7. Please only bring a mobile phone to school if you really need to.
