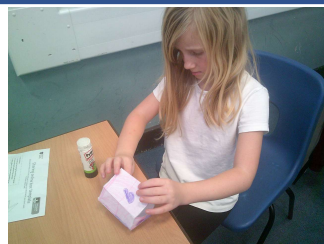




## PSHE
