Bernstein Class



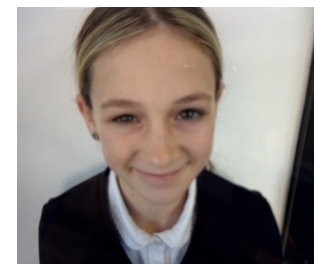
M is our star learner this week for always trying her hardest in her learning. She takes a lot of pride in her presentation and her work is a delight to see. Well done M!

Dun Class



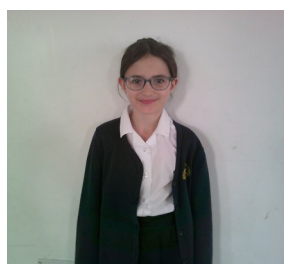
Our star learner is O for his brilliant reading of a Sherlock Holmes story independently. Well done O!

Holst Class



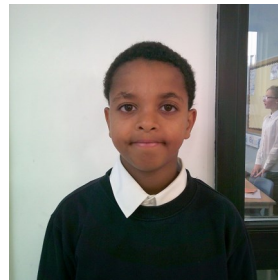
B is our star learner for always showing our core values brilliantly! She actioned her next steps in writing and as a result she has produced a wonderful piece of suspense writing.
