Zimmer Class



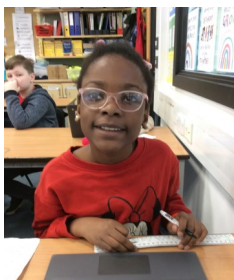
I is our star learner because she has been trying really hard in maths. She has been showing independence in her learning. She can recognise lots of coins whilst learning about money.
