Price Class



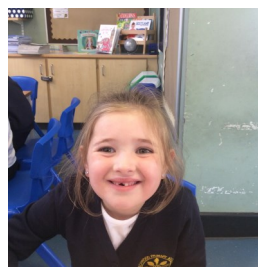
Our star learner this week is C for working really hard in Maths. We have been learning about Place Value this week and C has been showing resilience in working out the tens and ones in numbers. Well done!

Lloyd-Webber Class



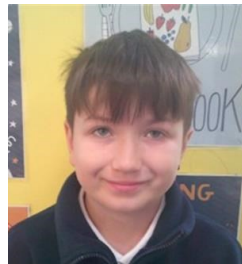
Our star this week is C for trying really hard to stay ready, respectful and safe in our classroom consistently. He is a great contributor and valued member of our classroom.

Dun Class



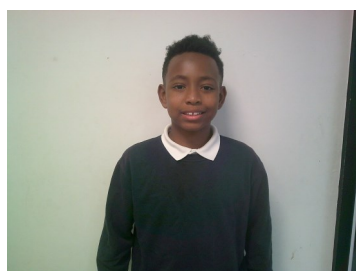
Our star learner is Z for his high quality writing this term. Well done Z!

Holst Class



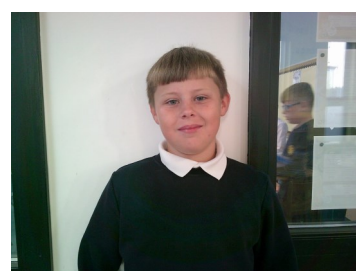
L is our star learner this week. He has been consistently actioning his next steps with his writing and has published a fantastic bargain letter linked to the narrative 'The Promise'.
