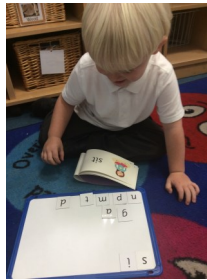

Dun Class



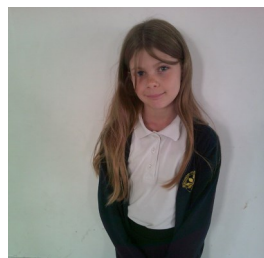
Our star of the week is A for his hard work in maths, confidently completing column addition and subtractions and setting himself extra challenges. Well done A!

Holst Class



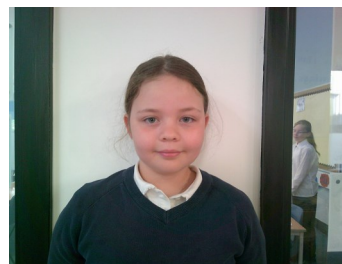
