Wembury Class





Mount Batten Class




T has had a great week. He has been working hard in class across the curriculum and has also been a great role model to the rest of the class, showing STAR. Well done!

Mt Edgcumbe Class





Dockyard Class




Our star learner this week is I for trying new work and working hard with teachers and friends with a very positive attitude. Well done I!
