On the reverse, please find an outline of your child's learning for Term 1 and 2.

We will be focusing on settling in and finding time to catch up with our friends and our new classes. We are so pleased to see the school full of children again and we are really impressed with the ambition we have seen in the classroom so far.

How you can help:

Reading books are changed when the children are ready to change their books in school and they have a Reading Journal that they can bring backwards and forwards from school to track their reading at home. Children are still using the Renaissance Reading program. Children should try to read with an adult every day; a good guide is 30 mins per day. It is even more helpful if you can ask them questions about what they have been reading, or to predict what they think will happen next.

Each week, your child will be given a list of spellings for their age group. They are tested once a week, on a Friday. You can really support your child by helping them to learn their spellings at home. A few minutes each evening or as you are walking to or from school will make all the difference.

Each week, the children will have a short times table test and when they have completed three of these with no errors, they will move onto their next times table. When they have learnt up to the 12x table, they will have a grid format which helps them remember all their tables. Children have access to a website called Times table Rockstars which they will have their password for and it helps them to practice their tables in an engaging way. You can also help by listening to the children recite their tables or asking questions for the children to answer.

PE

The children will continue to participate in PE sessions each week. Our topic this term is gymnastics and invasion games. **On our PE day, children will be required to wear their PE kit into school. PE will take place on Thursday and Friday** The children will be going outside and will need suitable outside kit including trainers or plimsolls. School PE kit is a white t-shirt, black or blue shorts, clean socks and trainers or plimsolls. Earrings must be removed for PE by the child, or not worn to school on that day please

Religious Education

All year groups study a range of religious beliefs in a knowledge capacity. In terms 1 and 2, we will be learning about Christians and the Islamic religion.

MATHS: Our priority this term is to reinforce prior learning of place value and the four mathematical operations, as well as consolidating these principles to answer a range of mental and written problems. An emphasis will also be placed on developing a secure recall of number facts and times tables.



COMPUTING: As the theme is Romans, Year 5 will be simple 3-D models of Roman ruins using an app on the Chrome books. They will be taking their inspiration from photographs and video footage.



ENGLISH: Year 5 will start the term focusing on explanation texts and a narrative. The children will be immersed in the story by doing lots of role play and word related activities. The children will explore descriptive writing and linked aspects of grammar. They will also be learning the key reading skills and applying them to each chapter as well as their own reading books.

TERM 1: How did the Romans change Britain?

Book: Beowulf
and The Princess that hid in tree.

SCIENCE: In Science this term, the children will be studying Animals including humans, which includes puberty. We will be looking at the stages of growth from babies until elderly.



DT: In design and technology we will be investigating Anglo-Saxon clothing, the children will be creating their own stylish piece.



HISTORY: Year 5 will be studying the Roman and Anglo-Saxons this term. Focusing on the influence and impact of the Roman Empire.

PSHE: In Autumn term 1, the children will be learning about Diversity and what makes us unique.



ENGLISH: We will be linking our English to our space learning this term. Cosmic is based on space so we will be looking at space poetry..

SCIENCE: This term we will be studying the solar system. We will be looking at planets in depth; describing the movement of the Earth and other planets in relation to the sun and explaining why night and day happens.



MFL: We have a real focus on our MFL this year, our schools language is French. Year 5 will be learning about the weather, hobbies and CHRISTMAS!



MATHS: Our work this term will focus on Multiplication and Division linked to our times table knowledge which is crucial and an on-going school target. We will continue to work on key facts recall and support the children with any gaps in knowledge.

TERM 2: Space
Book: Cosmic by Frank Cottrell-Boyce



ART: Year 5 will be printing in the style of Andy Warhol's space prints using polystyrene.



MUSIC: We will be composing and performing a 30-second piece of music about a planet, inspired by Holst – the planets. Children will also learn how to use musical notation.
