Please submit your consent by **midday on 7th October 2024** at the very latest to ensure your child receives the vaccination.





This beginner-friendly course is designed to guide you through the fundamentals of machine sewing, from selecting fabrics and tools to mastering basic stitches and techniques. By the end of the course, you'll have completed a lined Tote bag with pocket to take home. You will achieve confidence and basic skills in machine sewing and a sense of creative empowerment.

What will I learn?

Week 1: Get to know your Sewing Machine: Gain confidence in machine sewing. Learn about essential sewing tools and materials. Practise basic sewing techniques.

Week 2: Mastering Basic Stitches: Learn the essential stitches used in sewing projects, including straight stitch, Zig Zag and Hemming. Practice techniques on sample fabrics. Introduction on how to use basic Sewing Patterns.

Week 3: Design a Tote Bag: Design & chose colour/ patterned cloth for your Tote Bag. Using a simple sewing pattern cut out Tote Bag.

Week 4: Construct Tote Bag: Put your skills into action! Focusing on finishing techniques like seam finishing and adding embellishments.

Week 5: Constructing & Complete a Tote Bag. Continue working on your Tote Bag and complete your sewing project. Sharing & Reflecting : Showcase your completer projects, share your experiences and take your Tote Bag home!!!

Free School Meals

You may be entitled to apply for Free School Meals for your child/ren if you receive the following benefits:-

- Universal Credit, Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance,
- Income Related Element of Employment and Support Allowance,
- Guaranteed Credit element of Pension
 Credit
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of £16,190 or less.

We would urge parents who may be eligible for Free School Meals for the children to either apply on-line through the Plymouth City Council website or contact the school office for a form as soon as possible. This is very important, even if your child does not wish to take up the free meal. The register of FSM entitlement affects our overall school budget and we may be missing out on funding as a result.

Please so not confuse this with Universal Free School Meal entitlement for children in Years Reception to Year Two.
