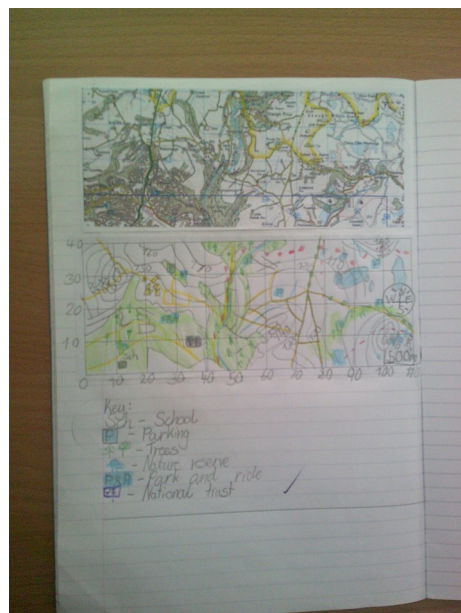


We tested our bridges load capacity by using different weights. It was incredible how much weight their bridges were able to hold!

The children have produced some fantastic work in our topic of Dartmoor this term. They have done a lot of map work, using 6 figure grid references and the eight points of the compass to create directions of a route around a local area and draw their own sketch maps of Dartmoor using symbols. They have been learning about living things in the habitats in science, particularly focusing on classifying living things and completing a mould experiment. They have written their own Dartmoor legend in English and learn about the history of folk music, collaborating and performing with the Dartmoor Border Morris. They have also researched bridges and strengthening techniques to create a design brief and build their own bridges.
