## Bernstein Class



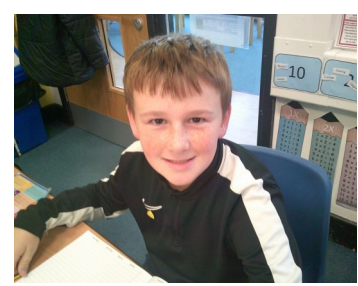
W is our star learner this week. She has shown incredible perseverance in maths this week. Well done W, keep up the good work.

## Dun Class



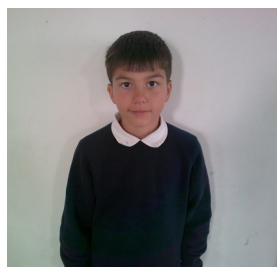
Our star learner this week is D for showing resilience in Maths. He has been working hard to understand multiplication using different strategies.

## Holst Class



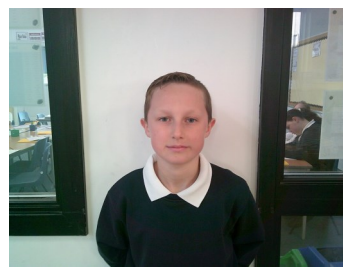
