Congratulations to all our Star Learners this week. We are proud of you all!

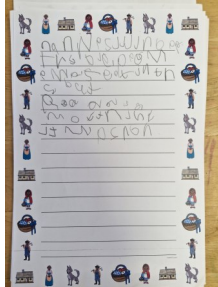

Dun Class



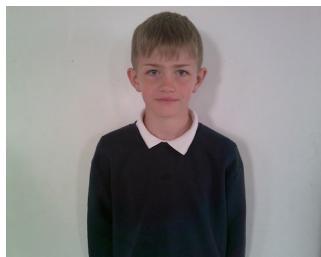
Our star learner is E for his narrative writing and exciting vocabulary. Well done E, keep up the good work!
