Price Class



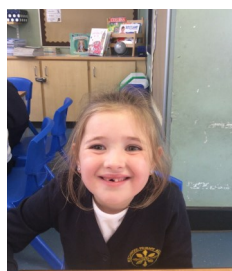
LL is our star learner this week for persevering and showing confidence to work independently. Well done LL!

Bernstein Class



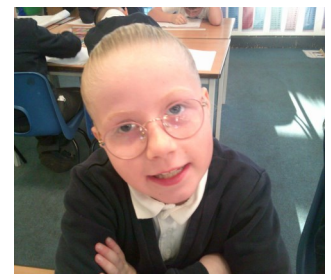
T is our star learner this week for achieving 25/25 in her spelling test as well as planning an exciting sounding narrative. Well done T!

Dun Class



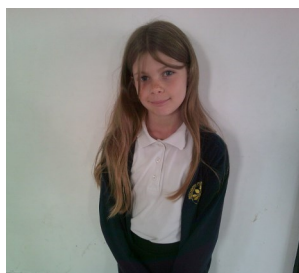
O is our star learner for his brilliant ideas in writing. Even his peers recognized his creativity. Well done O!

Holst Class



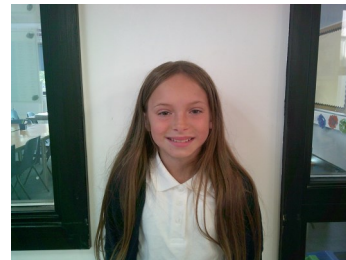
V consistently demonstrates RRS. She has written some fantastic sentences using similes and adjectives to describe the characters in her dilemma narrative. Well done V!
